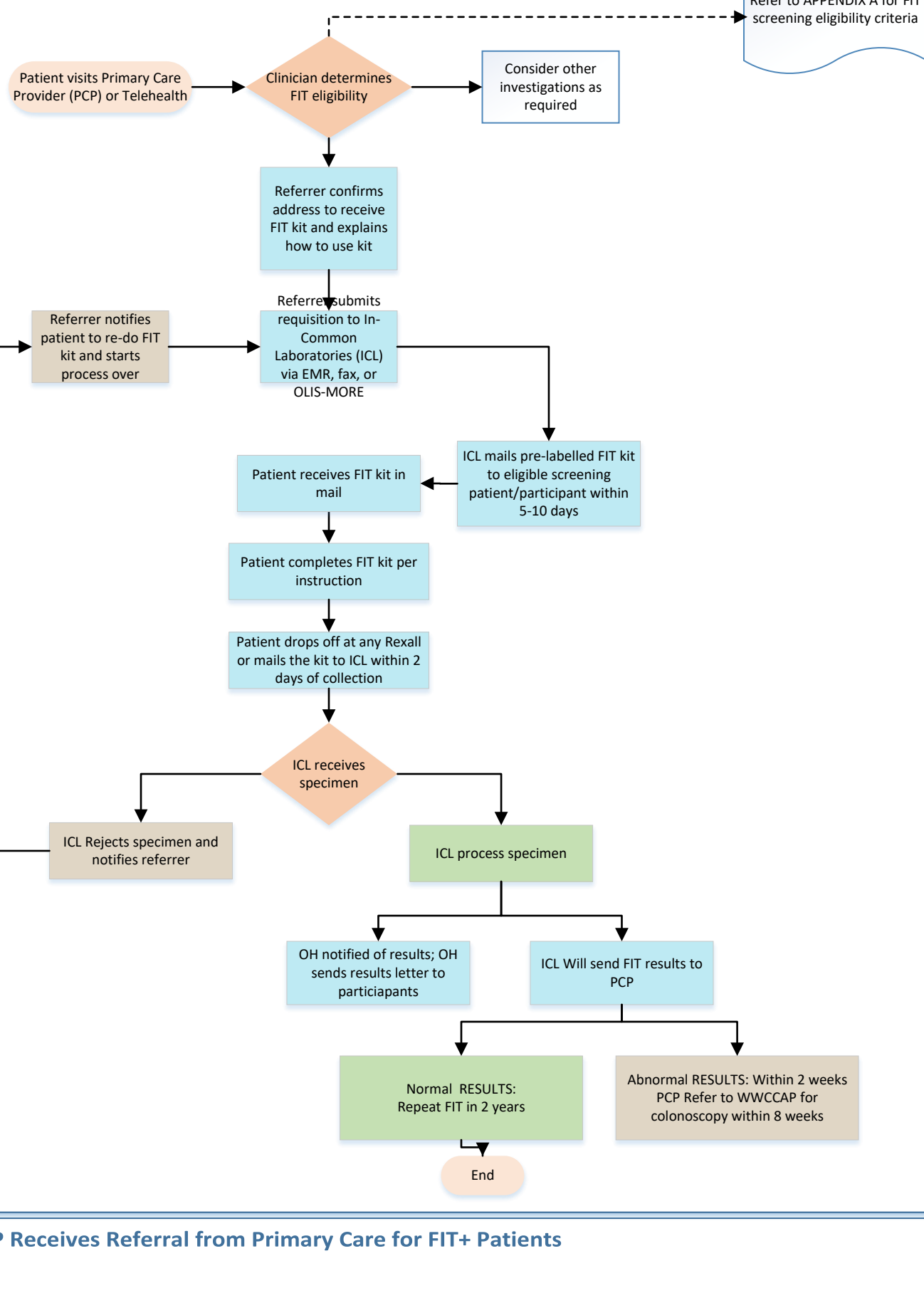
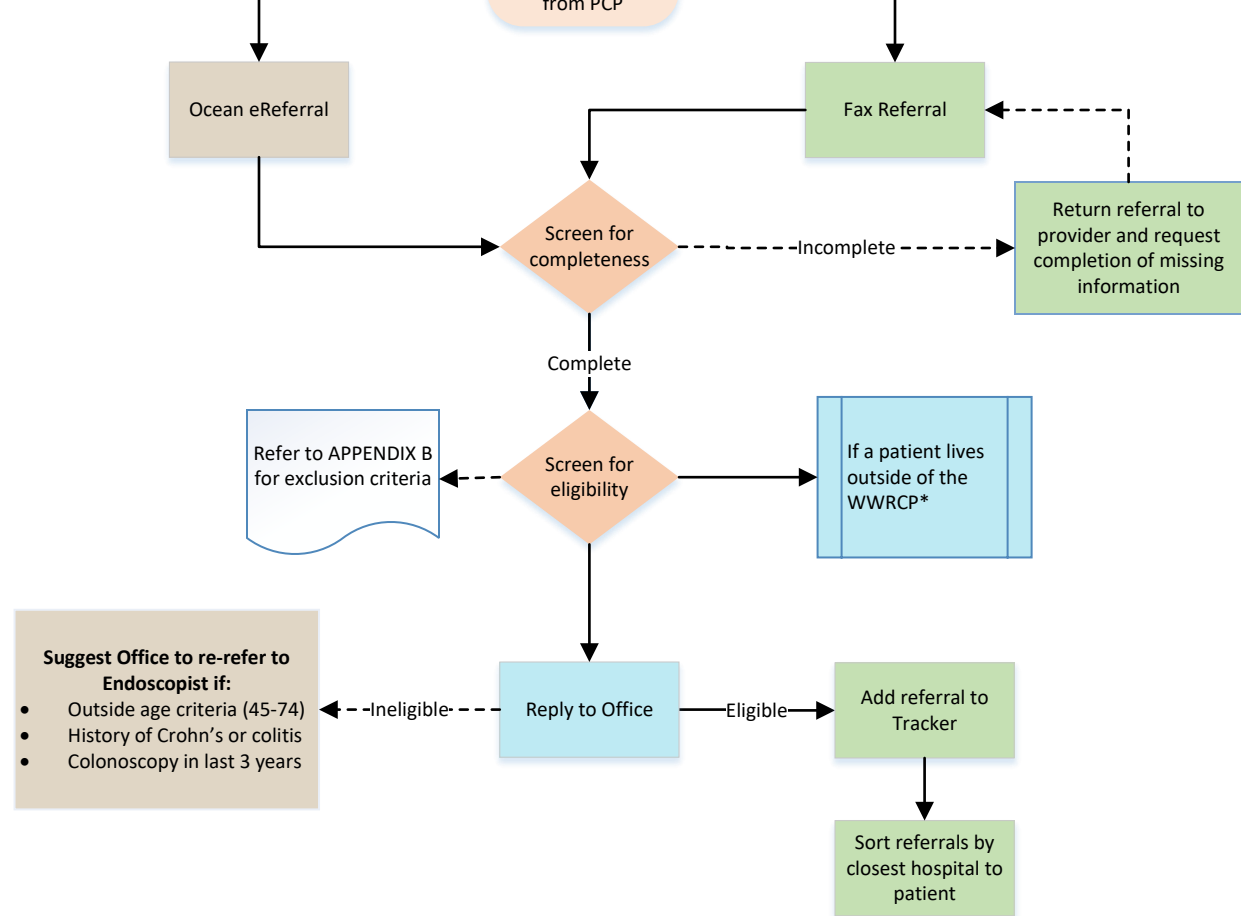


Pre-WWCCAP Pathway



1. WWCCAP Receives Referral from Primary Care for FIT+ Patients



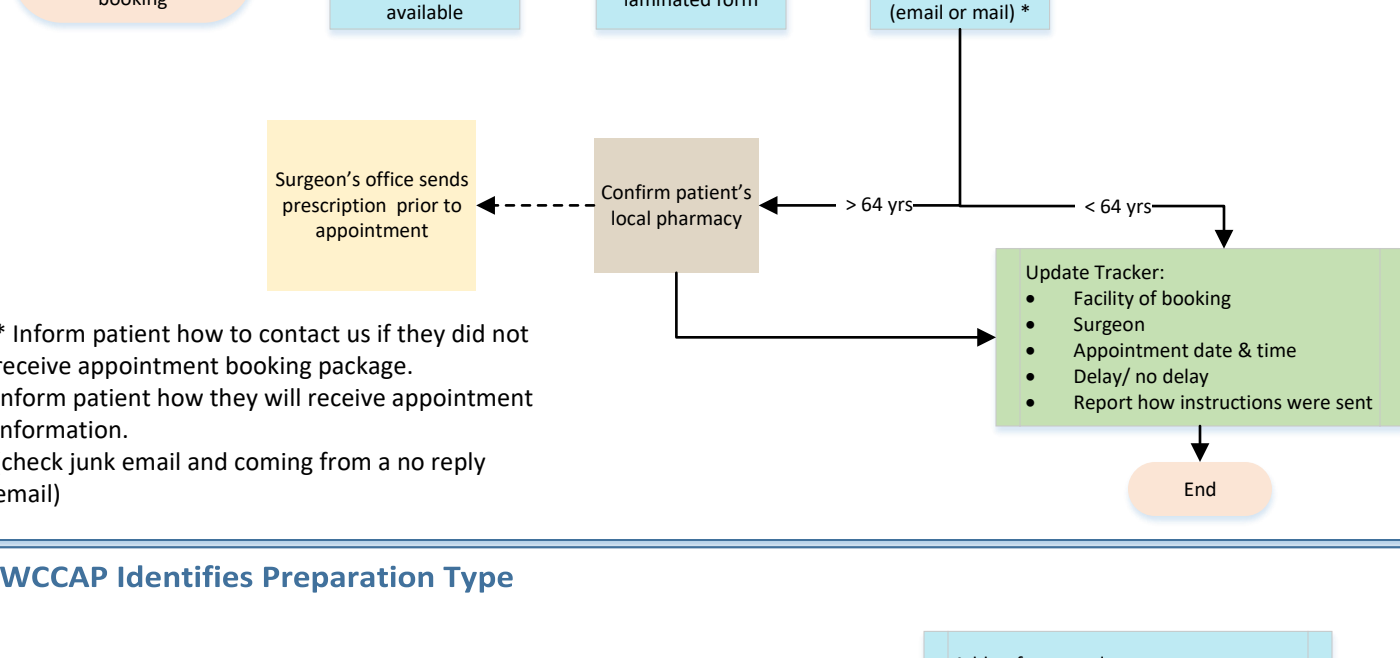
*Faxed referral:

Ask patient if they wish to travel this far for their colonoscopy and/or which hospital they would prefer to go to. ensure that hospital is on the list: <https://www.cancercareontario.ca/en/find-cancer-services/fit-colonoscopy/locations-list>. If happen to have the referral for that particular hospital is available, send it to them so they don't have to hunt for it.

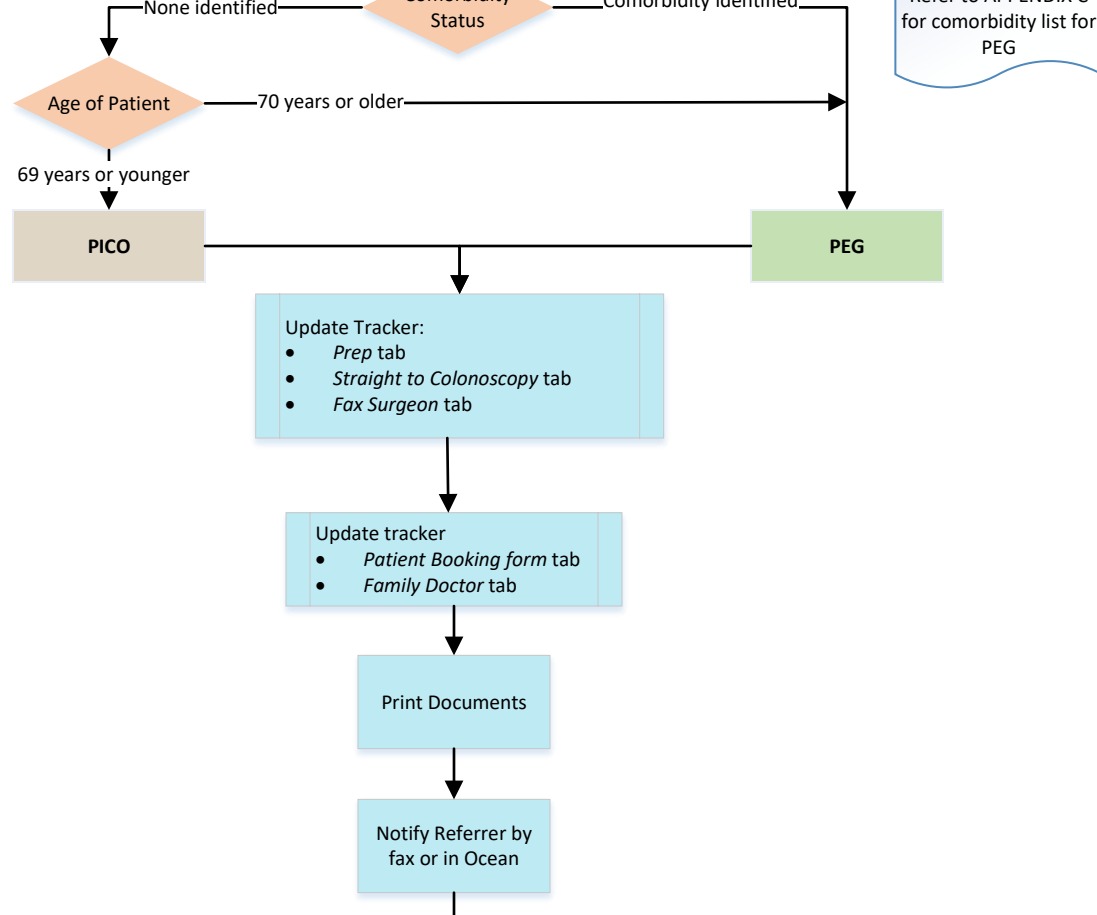
Ocean referral:

Message the office and suggest they speak with the patient to see if they wish to go to a hospital that is much closer to them. Let them know that Our program is unsure of their wait time or process.

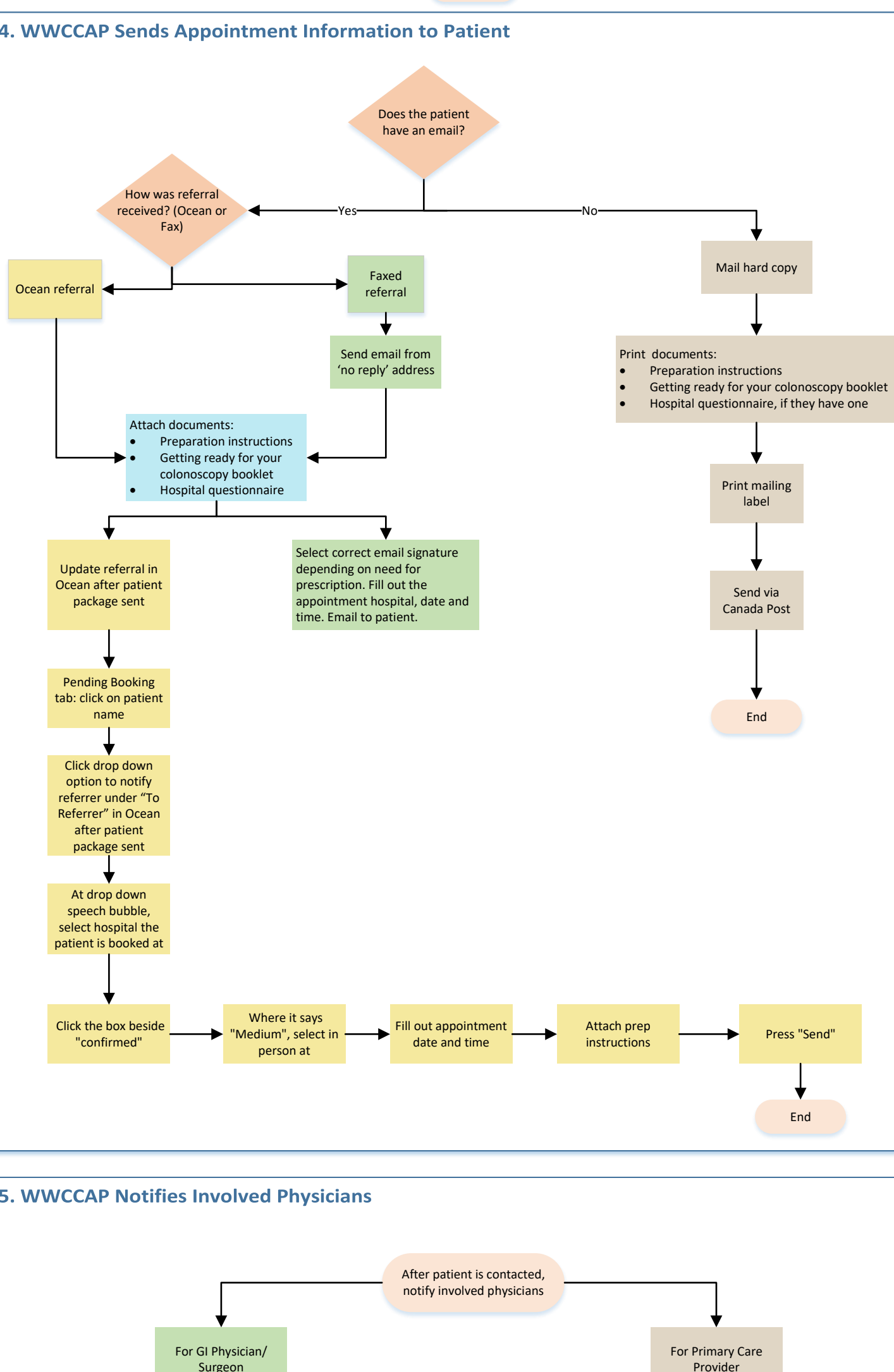
2. WWCCAP Books Appointment



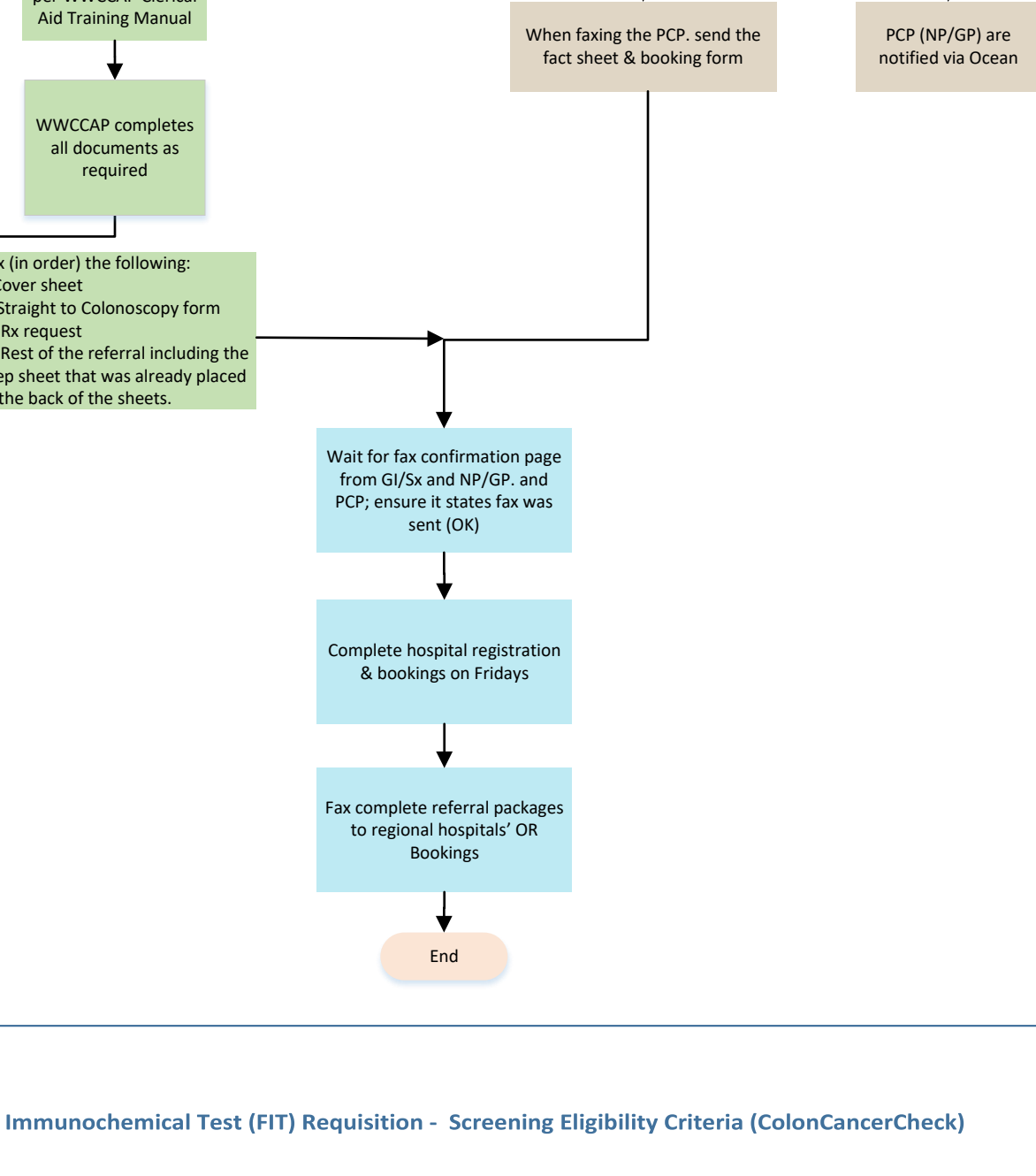
3. WWCCAP Identifies Preparation Type

Appendix A – Fecal Immunochemical Test (FIT) Requisition - Screening Eligibility Criteria (ColonCancerCheck)

Fecal Immunochemical Test (FIT) Requisition – For Immuno ColoRectal Cancer Screening

Eligibility Criteria:

- Age 45 to 74¹
- Due for screening (no FIT in the last two years, and no flexible sigmoidoscopy or colonoscopy in the last 10 years)
- Asymptomatic
- Ontario Health Insurance Plan (OHIP) coverage

¹ ColonCancerCheck does not recommend routine screening for people over 74 years. Decisions to screen those between the ages of 75 to 85 years should include an assessment of risks and benefits, and take into consideration health, life expectancy, and prior screening history. Requisitions will be accepted for people up to 85 years of age.

Note:

- Do not use for the workup of patients with GI symptoms, overt GI bleeding and/or anemia
- Do not use for patients with a personal history of colorectal cancer, Crohn's disease involving the colon or ulcerative colitis

Appendix B – WWCCAP Exclusion Criteria for Colonoscopy through FIT Testing

Requisitions will be declined by the WWCCAP if:

- Patients are not between ages 45-74
- If the FIT result is greater than 2 years
- Personal history of Crohn's disease (involving the colon) or ulcerative colitis
- Colonoscopy within 3 years

Appendix C – Comorbidity List for PEG

BOWEL PREPARATION

When to choose PEG based preparation:

- **70 or over**
- **Seizure disorders**
- **Cirrhosis**
- **Diabetes** (insulin and metformin)
- **Renal**
 - Previous renal cancer
 - History of kidney stones
 - Patient has one kidney
 - Increased CR levels
 - Patient is on dialysis
 - Impaired renal function
- **Risk of inadequate bowel preparation**
 - History of poor preparation
 - History of Constipation including patients on narcotics (including methadone)
 - Prior bowel resection
 - G.I disease (Diverticulitis, IBS, active inflammation)
- **Spinal cord injury**
- **Pregnant/breast feeding**
- **Parkinson's Disease**
- **Swallowing impairment**
- **Stroke**
- **Cardiovascular disease**
 - Previous myocardial infarction
 - Angina
 - Congestive heart failure
 - Irregular heart beat
